



## DR. GLEN SAVELL

Curtis Glen Savell, a.k.a Brother Glen, made an extraordinary impact on everyone he came in contact with. Whether it was his preachings in the pulpit, his strength in God, or just how sharp he always dressed; Glen was a man you would remember.

Brother Glen passed away peacefully at his home in Houston, MS on Friday, March 29, 2024, at the age of 82. He was born on September 18, 1941, to Curtis and Mavis Savell in Philadelphia, MS. He had two brothers, Dwight and Joey Savell. Glen loved his brothers dearly. They would try to see each other as often as they could, and they were never too old to outdo one another on a dare.

Glen attended Clarke College in Newton, MS where he met his first wife, Becky Seale. They were married for 34 years and had three beautiful daughters, Janea, Kristi, and Mitzi. Glen was a precious husband and father, and always made time for family.

His girls meant the world to him. Every time the church doors were open, his family would be there. His girls even had a singing group called Glen's Girls,

where they would sing before he preached his sermon.

He was a very educated man, who never wanted to stop learning. He graduated from Clarksville School of Theology where he received his Bachelor's degree. He also received a Master of Theology and a Doctor of Ministry degree.

Brother Glen was a pastor. He loved the Lord and wanted to share with everyone. He pastored churches in Florida, Mississippi, and Alabama (a Mississippi boy at heart, but loved Alabama football). He served over fifty years as a pastor, evangelist, and a teacher. Every church he pastored, experienced growth in every area. His last church was a county seat church in Linden, Alabama, which he pastored for fourteen years.

Though their relationship turned out to be less permanent than either of them expected, both Glen and Becky went on to live exceptional lives and stay close to their children. Brother Glen began Glen Savell Ministries and married Glenda Harrell in 1996 in Philadelphia, MS. Glenda worked for many years for the city of Houston, MS, but went on to be Glen's supporter and partner in his ministry. Brother Glen ministered over 400 evangelistic and revival meetings in his lifetime. Other accomplishments of Brother Glen include: Vice President of the Alabama Board of Pastors' Conference, member of the Board of Regents at the University of Mobile in Alabama and listed in the Who's Who In Religion.

Glen and Glenda lived their life in Mississippi where he served as an Associate Superintendent and Counselor/Instructor at the Home of Grace Christian Recovery Facility. He also became the founder and administrator of Joshua School for Biblical Studies in Kenya, Africa. Glen and Glenda were married for 27 years.

Brother Glen was preceded in death by his father, Curtis, and his mother, Mavis Spears Savell

He is survived by his wife, Glenda, his daughters, Janea Savell, Kristi Pulmano, and Mitzi Winesette; his stepdaughter, Kristy Skelton, and his stepson, Kelly Harrell; children's spouses; his two brothers, Dwight Savell and Joey Savell; cousins, nieces, grandchildren, and his great-grandchildren.
