He was born December 4, 1924, in Merryville, Louisiana. He was the son of Hiram Carey Morgan and Lillian Nichols Morgan. Church assembly was always the most important part of his life. He was a deacon and served in this capacity in many of his church homes as well as, taught Sunday School and served on many committees. His love for Jesus Christ was exemplified in his love for the church.
