Funeral services for Mr. Kelly Murray Branning was held Monday, February 24, 2014 at John E. Stephens Chapel with Rev. John Stephens officiating. Mr. Branning's wish was to have a private funeral surrounded by his immediate family members. Interment was in Bluff Springs Baptist Church Cemetery in Kemper County. John E.
