Mr. Stephens, 90, was born in Pascagoula, MS on May 4, 1923 and moved to Neshoba County in 1924. He served in the U.S. Army Infantry in Europe and was awarded The Purple Heart and the bronze star. He was a member of Military Order of the Purple Heart. He received a BS degree from MS Southern College in 1949. He was a school teacher for four years. He was a member of the Mississippi National Guard for two years. Mr. Stephens moved to Flint, MI where he served in Michigan National Guard for ten years, retiring as captain in 1964. He retired January 1984 from General Motors Corporation in Flint, MI after 30 years of service. He returned to Mississippi in 1984 and raised cattle for a number of years. He passed away on Tuesday, November 12, 2013 at Neshoba County Nursing Home. He was a member of Mt. Olive Baptist Church in the Stephenstown Community.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Lonnie Lee Stephens & Louva Bell Clark Stephens; brothers, Clifford (Maurice) Stephens & James Paul Stephens.

Mr. Stephens is survived by sisters, Mildred Mott of Union, MS & Mary Louise Huston of Union, MS.
