She moved to Florida where she set up a library in Seminole County. She worked at Florida A&M for three years. She moved to Bartow, Florida and worked in the Polk County School system for 30 years.

She was a member of Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Bartow, FL.

In 1984, she retired and later returned to Philadelphia in 1989.

After returning to Philadelphia she was a strong supporter of Hopewell UMC. She was affiliated and shared Eucharist from St. Francis Episcopal Church.

Pearlean enjoyed baking, reading, sending cards and daily conversations with her favorite relatives.

In December 2013, she moved to Choctaw Residential Center where she made new friends and the staff became like her children. She always became bright-eyed and had such an inviting smile when anyone entered the room.

Pearlean is survived by 2 sisters, Bertha Smith, Okolona, MN and Juanita Harvey, Chicago, IL; sisters-in-law, Vida Moore, Jackson, MS and Alberta Moore, Minneapolis, MS; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
