Mrs. Sanna M. Heckman passed away on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at Atwood Personal Care Home in Philadelphia, MS. She was born in Rochester, Minnesota on August 9, 1924, a daughter of the late George and Rachel (Arnold) McKenney. She attended local schools including Rochester Junior College and served in the Women's Army Corps during World War II.

In 1946, in Clinton, Iowa she married Axel Skoglund and the couple subsequently made their home in Connecticut and upstate New York. He preceded her in death in 1972. In 1974, she moved to Oregon and in Eugene in 1978, she married Wendell Heckman. He died in 1991. In 1996, she moved to Mississippi.

In addition to her parents and husbands, she was preceded in death by two sisters and two brothers. She is survived by nieces and nephews.

Gravesite services and burial will be held at Center Grove Cemetery in Douglas, Minnesota at a later date.

Mrs. Heckman was an avid reader and journal keeper, a religious and political liberal and a lifelong supporter of animal rights and environmental issues. She loved antiques and enjoyed foreign travel.
