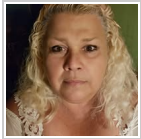
Susie will be greatly missed by all her family and friends. Her final words to us would be for us to be happy and live our life like there is no tomorrow. I love you all!

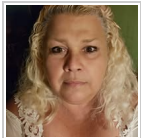
